Basketball Awards Given Out at Banquet

At the annual awards banquet held in the school cafeteria Monday night the 1965 Bobcat Basketball team was honored by their coach Charles Creasey. He was introduced by the Master of Ceremonies for the evening, Mr. Marvin Hoppert.

Before handing out Varsity awards, Mr. Creasey commented on his first season as Grand Blanc's head coach. "The league this year was as tough as I have ever seen it. League winner Ainsworth was knocked out of the Regional by a stiff Flint Northwestern. Clio went to the quarter finals and were as good as Fenton. Owosso was the toughest team for us. They played their best games both times we played them. Beecher won their district and Kearsley beat Lapeer in their district. Our losing to Clio and Mt. Morris in those close games hurt us badly. If we could have gotten a good start it would have made a difference. But these kids hustled every game. They never quit. They've got lots of heart. It takes lots of heart to keep trying even when you're behind."

Seniors receiving awards were Craig Phillips, Jim Jewett, Don Ellis, Jim Reed, Terry McClelland, Len Gawron, Rich Ward and Captain Tom Dulude. Ward was the team leading scorer with a 13.9 average and 9.6 rebounds per game.

Juniors Bill Wagner, Chris Schneider, Tom Ruhrop, Craig Cox, Bob Miller, Dan McAuliffe and Mike Morrison were given their awards. Mr. Creasey pointed out that Morrison had been the most improved player this year. Managers Sam Catanese and Dennis Allen were also given awards.

Seven Juniors forming a good nucleus will be back next year. Creasey encouraged them, "we can have a real good ball club next year. You have to want to be good. We have lots of heart and lots of ability. We didn't have a bad team this year, we just had lots of bad luck. To the Seniors—Come back and see us. You will always be a part of the team. And you parents, too. Even though your boy isn't playing come back and see us."
